#### **GIFT AID**

Are you a tax payer? Do you know that if you complete a Gift Aid Declaration form the Church can claim the tax back on your donations? (If you don't pay enough tax to cover the claim you would be required to pay the difference to HMRC via a declaration on your tax return.) Donations should either be paid directly into the Church's bank account by standing order (referencing your name) or via the collection plate in a numbered envelope supplied by the Gift Aid Secretary. Anyone interested in joining the scheme should speak to Christine Panton, Gift Aid Secretary. If you are not a tax payer, tax can still be reclaimed for donations by cash or cheque on the collection plate. (NO £50 NOTES can be accepted.) Please note donations paid directly into the bank are only admissible for tax reclamation if a Gift Aid Declaration form has been completed and lodged in the Church's safe. Christine Panton



## An update on the 1District/1 Circuit work

A member from each of the 3 working groups met with the District Council last week to update us on their work so far. Each of the groups has begun to produce a work plan and note the areas in which there is some overlapping interest, especially where conversations will need to be had with other people in the Circuits. Some information has already been gathered and next meetings scheduled.

One of the key areas we touched on was the need to do some far-sighted thinking about what might be possible to reshape our work and then to come back to our governing documents to see what might be possible within the framework and legislation of the Methodist Church. In other words we are not starting from the question of 'what are we allowed to do?' But what might we want to do and could this happen? To this end the Governance Group has re-named itself the 'Making it Work' group with the positivity that this encompasses.

In a further renaming, Mission and Discipleship is now Discipleship and Mission. A small but significant change, noting the priority of our own understanding of being disciples (learners) of Jesus which will then enable and influence our carrying out of God's work in our communities.

The Resources group continues to be the Resources group.

Please continue to hold the groups in your prayers. They have a significant amount of work to do, some of which is quite complex.
